

SAFETY PROGRAMME:

METUNG YACHT CLUB

1. All boats racing must comply with Yachting Australia Special Regulations for equipment required under Category 7 and with the Victorian Boating Regulations.
2. A Category 7 Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form, available on the Metung Yacht Club website. These shall be completed by the owner or their representative and presented prior to first race.
3. Other Forms will be available on the [Club's Web Site](#) or hard copies can be made available.
4. The club requires proof of insurance cover, Certificate of Currency, to be produced at the audit.
5. Where a boat is required to be registered under Victorian Boating Regulations the current Certificate of Registration must also be produced.
6. Safety audits are self-regulatory, forms must be sighted by Race Officer of the Day.
7. Working radios are required by all vessels.
8. A Man Overboard Drill is highly recommended each season. Follow links to RRS special regulations appendix E and also maritime safety section Transport Safety Victoria.
9. All radios are required to be in working order
10. Radio checks are important

Note:

- PFD-1 annual inspection certificates are required and may be completed by the owner, follow manufacturers instructions.
- Emergency flares must be in date.
- Fire extinguishers must be in date.
- First Aid kits must comply with Special Regulation 4.07-9.
