THE MYC MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

Do you know how to help somebody if they ask you how to become a MYC member?

The processes is as follows:

- 1/ The prospective member needs to fill out an application form including all the requested information (there are separate forms for adults and children). Forms are available at the Club or from our website under "Club Documents".
- 2/ To be eligible for Junior membership a person must be under 18 years of age on 1 July of the current financial year. Intermediate Membership is available from age 18 years to the end of the financial year in which they turn 25 (a reduced subscription rate applies to full time students). Full Membership is available for persons aged 18 and over (if both partners of a couple are Full Members, a reduced Partner Rate applies to one of them).
- 3/ The application form must be signed by a valid "proposer" and "seconder" who must be financial members of the Club, have been members for over 12 months and are not from the same immediate family unit.
- 4/ The completed form can be posted to the Club (PO Box 60, Metung, Vic. 3904), handed to a General Committee Member or scanned and emailed to the Membership Coordinator (metungyachtclub.membership@gmail.com).
- 5/ The applicable membership fees are detailed in the MYC Fee Schedule and on the application forms and must be paid before the application can be considered by the Committee. Direct deposit to our bank account is our preferred method (the Club's banking details are on the form).
- 6/ A Notice of Application must be posted on the Club Notice Board for 14 days before it can be considered by the Club Committee for approval at their next meeting. During the notice period, written objections to be considered by the Club Committee can be lodged with the Honorary Secretary by any financial member.
- 7/ Membership commences from the date of approval by the Club Committee.
